

School districts throughout New York State have been notified by the State Education Department that a suspicious e-mail was sent to state officials and the news media referencing threats of violence to state office buildings, the State legislature and school buses. The district has been notified by SED that the Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Services do not consider the threat to be credible at this time.

The bus companies providing transportation services for our district have been notified of the threat and shared the concerns with drivers and dispatchers. Principals and staff have been reminded of the importance of being diligent in watching for suspicious or unusual behavior in and around our school buses.

We will continue to be vigilant in our commitment to ensure the safety of our students in our schools and buses.
